

PHSCE and R.E.

Children will be exploring the theme of 'New Beginnings'. We will also talk about stories from The Bible and the focus question will be 'What did Jesus teach?'

Music

The children will discover ways to use their voices to describe feelings and moods. Also they will create, notate and perform vocal sounds, building to a performance.

Literacy

In Literacy we will be following the Read, Write Inc. scheme of work which will take place every day. We will be focusing upon writing and punctuating good quality sentences as well as reading unfamiliar words.

Our written work will be linked to stories in familiar settings. We will plan and tell stories based on their own experience. They use the structure from shared writing to write their own complete stories.

Art African Art

Children will explore the colours and patterns of the African landscape and native tribes. They will look at the Maasai culture and their amazing homemade jewellery. Children will learn how to make and decorate tribal masks and admire the African Sunsets.

Physical Development

In P.E. the children will be introduced to Games. They will be practising ball handling, kicking, carrying and striking. They will be creating and playing games, individually, pairs and in teams.

Computing

We will be learning about coding. Children will learn that objects can be programmed to move when a key is pressed and that, that key pressed is called an event.

WOW STARTER: Taste fruit from Kenya



Science: Super Scientists

This half term we will be learning about different scientist such as Louis Pasteur, Isaac Newton, Thomas Edison and Alexander Graham Bell. We will look at their discoveries while developing our own working scientific skills. Using practical, fun activities we will investigate gravity, light and medical science and learn how germs are spread.

Mathematics

In Maths we will learn to read and write two-digit and three-digit numbers in figures and words; describe and extend number sequences and recognise odd and even numbers. We will order two-digit numbers and position them on a number line; use the greater than (>) and less than (<) signs. We will estimate a number of objects. We will add or subtract mentally a one-digit number or a multiple of 10 to or from any two-digit number; use practical and informal written methods to add and subtract two-digit numbers.

Geography

Let's go on Safari - Kenya

This term we will be talking about what it would be like to go on safari to Africa with a Geography scheme of work for Year 2. We will join explorers as they visit Kenya and meet the people, wildlife and landscapes. Children will learn where Kenya is on a map and undertake a variety of fun activities to help them learn more about Kenya and compare it to the UK.
